

2022/23 PRE-PROFESSIONAL PROGRAM

For students interested in comprehensive dance training leading to a potential career in performance or teaching. Acceptance into the program is by recommendation or audition only and is based on the student's physical & artistic suitability together with their commitment and dedication to dance. Students study classical ballet, pointe, exam work, jazz, contemporary, tap, musical theatre, hip hop and acro under the guidance of a highly qualified and accomplished teachers. Students must attend a min. of 6 hours per week of compulsory classes in ballet, pointe, jazz & contemporary.

Curriculum also includes extra rehearsals, workshops, performances, cultural and dance related outings, stage make-up application and teacher's examinations. WSD encourages all PPP students to take additional classes over and above program requirements. To facilitate this, all additional classes for PPP students receive a 50-70% tiered discount.
